DRAFT BY-LAWS TO GOVERN
COACHES OF STATE SQUADS AND TEAMS

1.0 NOMINATION

The BAWA Secretary or Executive Officer will send out nomination forms for State Team Coaches at the appropriate times.

Those parties interested in the position of Coach must submit the BAWA nomination form to the nominated address no later than the stipulated date or such other date as determined by the Board of Management.

2.0 APPOINTMENT

2.1 The BAWA Board of Management will make the appointment from the nominations received.

2.2 Should no suitable nominations be received or a vacancy occur for any reason, the BAWA Board of Management shall appoint a Coach.

3.0 REQUIREMENTS

3.1 The person applying for the Coach's position shall be a registered member of BAWA and have a police clearance or Working with Children Certificate, at the time of selection or appointment.

3.2 The Coach should have a recognised coaching qualification.

3.3 Preference may be given to the Coach with the highest coaching qualification.

3.4 The appointed Coach must be conversant with the Codes of Conduct pertaining to players and officials.

3.5 The appointed Coach must be conversant with the BAWA Risk Management Policy

4.0 DUTIES

4.1 Documentation

The Coach must meet with the BAWA Secretary and a member of the BAWA Board of Management to receive copies of relevant by-laws and receive any other instructions as required.

4.2 Player preparation

The Coach will work to develop each player's full potential both on and off the court. The Coach shall develop an effective training programme and shall provide a copy of this training programme to the players and the Board.

4.3 Competition

The Coach shall plan a competition schedule to assist players to reach their highest level leading into the National Carnival.

During such competition the Coach shall observe and advise players, to develop their skills and tactics.

4.4 Private Coach relationship

The Coach shall consult with the player's private coach in order to achieve a cooperative working relationship for the benefit of the player.

4.5 Team Selection

The Coach shall be a Selector and will provide the other Selectors with a constructive analysis of each player's performance to assist in selecting the best team possible for WA.

- 4.6 Liaison
The Coach shall liaise with the Manager on all matters pertaining to the team.
- 4.7 Player Code of Conduct
The Coach is to support the Manager in ensuring the Player's Code of Conduct is followed and enforced.
- 4.8 Fund-Raising
The Coach shall assist the Manager in all fund-raising activities.
- 4.5 Role at Carnival
The Coach shall have prime responsibility for the players on-court performance, providing court-side coaching when allowable, and discussing and analysing with the players their performance during de-brief sessions.
The Coach shall be a Selector on tour (except when the Coach is ineligible because he/she is a relative of a player), and in the event of dispute the Coach's decision will prevail.
- 4.6 Team meetings
The Coach, shall attend team meetings.
- 4.7 Final Report
The Coach shall liaise with the Manager in the writing of the Final Report
