

The Badminton Association of Western Australia (Inc.)
DRAFT BY-LAWS TO GOVERN
SELECTORS OF STATE TEAMS

1.0 NOMINATION

The BAWA Secretary or Executive Officer will advertise for State Team Selectors at appropriate times.

Those parties interested in the position of Selector must submit the BAWA nomination form to the nominated address no later than the stipulated date or such other date as determined by the Board of Management.

2.0 APPOINTMENT

2.1 The BAWA Board of Management will make the appointment from the nominations received.

2.2 Should no suitable nominations be received or a vacancy occur for any reason, the BAWA Board of Management shall appoint Selectors.

2.3 There shall be a maximum of three (3) Selectors for each State team- one of whom shall be the Coach of the relevant team.

2.4 The appointment of the Selectors shall expire upon the selection of the team.

3.0 REQUIREMENTS

3.1 The person applying for a Selector's position shall be a registered member of BAWA, but no Selector may have an immediate relative within the nominees.

3.2 The Selector shall have an understanding of, and a commitment to, the game of badminton.

3.3 The Selector shall observe the need for discretion regarding the selection of players.

3.4 The Selector must be conversant with all the BAWA Player's Code of Conduct.

3.5 The Selector must be conversant with the BAWA Risk Management Policy

4.0 DUTIES

4.1 Documentation

The Selector must meet with the BAWA Secretary and a member of the BAWA Board of Management to receive copies of relevant by-laws and receive any other instructions as required.

4.2 Trials

The Selector(s) in conjunction with the team Coach and Manager must organise and attend the team trials and necessary play-off matches.

The Selectors must keep records of trial results.

4.3 Competition

The Selector(s) may observe players and take into account results from competitions, apart from the specific trials,

- 4.4 Selection
The Selector(s) must select the State team strictly in accordance with the Bylaws to govern such selection.
- 4.5 Reporting
The Selector(s) are to report, in writing, to the Board of Management within two (2) weeks of the final selection event and such report to include:
Naming the players recommended to the Board;
Listing any Reserves, if requested to do so;
Any recommendations for the future.
- 4.6 Liaison
The Selector(s) are to liaise with the Team Coach and Manager on any relevant matter .
- 4.5 Selectors on tour
Selectors on tour shall be the Coach and Manager (Under 15, Under 17, Under 19) and shall include the Team Captain for the senior Team, provided that in the event of the dispute for the Under 15, Under 17 and under 19 teams the Coach's decision shall prevail(except where the Coach or Manager is a relative of a player, when the only selector shall be the other.)
