

## **GUIDELINES FOR STATE TEAMS**

There are Codes of Conduct for MEMBERS, COACHES, OFFICIALS, and PARENTS/GUARDIANS of Badminton WA.

There is a PLAYER AGREEMENT Form to be signed by players selected in State Teams.

There are ByLaws relating to COACHES, MANAGERS, SELECTORS AND PLAYERS.

There are ByLaws to govern the Selection of ALL State Teams

These GUIDELINES support the ByLaws

### **VAL NESBITT TROPHY: Under 15 Championships**

- Players must be under 15 years of age at the 31<sup>st</sup> of December in the year of the event.
- Selectors to choose a team of 3 boys and 3 girls to compete, unless otherwise decided by the BOM.
- Other nominees not selected in the team are eligible to play in the Individual Championships.
- A Coach, Manager and Chaperone(if required) to be selected to train and accompany the team.

### **JUNE BEVAN TROPHY: Under 17 Championships**

- Players must be under 17 years of age at the 31<sup>st</sup> of December in the year of the event.
- Selectors to choose a team of 5 boys and 5 girls to compete, unless otherwise decided by the BOM.
- Other nominees not selected in the team are eligible to play in the Individual Championships.
- A Coach, Manager and Chaperone(if required) to be selected to train and accompany the team.
- The Geraldton and Districts Badminton Association is sanctioned to send a regional team each year, due to its participation since inauguration of the event.

### **C.P. MADDERN TROPHY: Under 19 Championships**

- Players must be under 19 years of age at the 31<sup>st</sup> of December in the year of the event.
- Selectors to choose a team of 5 boys and 5 girls to compete, unless otherwise decided by the BOM.
- Other nominees not selected in the team are eligible to play in the Individual Championships.
- A Coach, Manager and Chaperone(if required) to be selected to train and accompany the team.

### **EDE CLENDINNEN SHIELD: OPEN Championships**

- No age limit
- Selectors to choose a team of 5 boys and 5 girls to compete, unless otherwise decided by the BOM.
- Other nominees not selected in the team are eligible to play in the Individual Championships.
- A Coach and Manager to be selected to train and accompany the team.

It is the responsibility of Badminton WA to advertise (through website/newsletters) the positions of Coach and Manager for each team, to set nomination dates and close of nomination dates and to select both positions within three weeks of the close of nominations. Badminton WA must notify nominees of their selection or non-selection within three weeks of the close of nominations. Once the players are selected in the team then the Coach and Manager become responsible for all training, and organisation so the team is well prepared for the event.

It is the responsibility of Badminton WA to advertise (through website/newsletters) Player nominations for each team, to set nomination dates and close of nomination dates and to appoint Selectors. Selectors plan the trials, if required, and choose the team. This team is given to the BOM for ratification. Badminton WA must notify players of their selection or non-selection within three weeks of the conclusion of the trials.
