Board Authority This Policy is made under authority of the BWA Constitution. It is binding on all Members of BWA and is to be interpreted in accordance with the BWA Constitution.

Section 23 of the Badminton Association of WA Inc. CONSTITUTION deals with **MEMBERS DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE.**

This Disciplinary Policy confirms the details as outlined in the Constitution.

Note:

The reasons for disciplinary action are shown as:

- 1. A breach of the Constitution or the Bylaws of the BAWA and/or any affiliated association of club;
- 2. An act of unbecoming conduct;
- 3. An act which is detrimental to the interest of BAWA or affiliated association or club;
- 4. An act which is detrimental to the game of badminton.

Penalties (as shown in the Constitution) can be:

- 5. Expulsion from the BAWA;
- 6. Suspension from the BAWA;
- 7. Penalties as deemed fit.

The Disciplinary procedure shall follow:

- 8. For a minor breach: a meeting between the party involved and two Board Members. Board Members to report to the Board.
- 9. Anything further shall follow the procedure as shown in the Constitution.
